INSTRUCTIONS

1. Eligibility

A. A high school student enrolled in their 10th or 11th year (Sophomore or Junior) in a high school serving or substantially serving the same area as Ninnescah Rural Electric Cooperative.

B. Students who wish to enter the Youth Tour Contest must complete the "Parent-Student" Release form, signed by student and parent and return it to Ninnescah Rural Electric Cooperative, P.O. Box 967, Pratt, KS., 67124-0967, **by Tuesday, December 3, 2019.**

Student Personal Information Forms will be mailed to participating students on **Monday, December 30, 2019.** We request that the completed Student Personal Information Forms be returned to Ninnescah Rural Electric Cooperative, P.O. Box 967, Pratt, KS 67124-0967, no later than **Monday, January 6, 2020,** in order to remain eligible for the contest.

C. By approval of the Board of Trustees, any student (sophomore or junior) whose parents or guardians are members shall be eligible to participate in the contest and those living in our service territory may participate even though the service is not in their parent's name.

2. All contestants will meet at Ninnescah Rural Electric Cooperative's office where they will take a short written examination under supervision and will be personally interviewed by the judges. The written examination will be over the Student Reference Kit mailed to each contestant.

3. Final winners will be determined on the basis of their total presentation.

4. All decisions of the judges are final.
